Discontinuation of Old Cotton Notes

Please be advised that the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago stated from January 1st, 2022, banknotes in the denominations of \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20 and \$50 shall **cease to be legal tender** for cash payment within Trinidad and Tobago.

To facilitate this, the Trinidad and Tobago Unit Trust Corporation has taken a decision to discontinue accepting the old cotton notes from **December 17th, 2021.**

This means that by **December 17th, 2021** the following will take effect:

- 1. Deposits: The \$1, \$5, \$10 \$20 and \$50 cotton notes issued prior to January 2021 will no longer be accepted by UTC as legal tender for deposits at any UTC ATM, Investment Centre or agent.
- **2. Exchanges:** However, the exchange of these notes will continue to be facilitated by Central Bank from January 1st, 2022.
